

Pfälzerhütte

HÜTTEN

Alpine peace, warm hospitality, and a unique location at 2,108 meters.

The **Pfälzerhütte** sits at 2,108 meters on the Bettlerjoch, just north of the Naafkopf and right on the border between Austria and Switzerland – on Liechtenstein territory. It's a popular base for hikers and offers shelter in summer to those on long-distance treks, such as the Via Alpina or the Liechtenstein Trail.

The hut is open and staffed from mid-June until mid/late October, depending on conditions. During the winter months, it remains closed – however, the nearby Adler emergency shelter is open year-round and provides basic accommodation.

With its rustic charm, regional food, and stunning panoramic views, the Pfälzerhütte is the perfect stopover or destination for a mountain day. It's also an ideal starting point for ascents to the Naafkopf (2,571 m) or for exploring the Liechtenstein Trail, which connects to the Brandner Glacier, the Mannheimer Hütte (2,679 m), and the Schesaplana (2,965 m).

Good to know: Overnight accommodation is limited – we recommend booking in advance.

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
